

PNG CUSTOMS COLLECTOR SALE 2017 GENERAL CONDITIONS



I. CONDITIONS FOR REGISTRATION

- a) All tenders must be placed in sealed A4 sized envelopes and forwarded to:

PNG Customs Service,
Southern Region Operations,
PO Box 1830,
PORT MORESBY

- b) Tenders will only be accepted if provided on the specified form. Verbal tenders will not be considered.
- c) Lodgement of tenders will close on **November 3, 2017**. Bidders must ensure that their tender is received by Customs by the due date because late submissions will not be considered.
- d) Interested bidders are required to strictly raise a Bank Cheque of K5,000.00 as registration to the Seized Goods Trust Account and present the cheque at the Customs office, ground floor. Do not pay registration directly into the Trust Account. No cash payments will be accepted.

- f) Unsuccessful bidders must produce the original receipt to Customs to get registration refund. Customs will not be liable to pay any costs associated to raising bank cheques or any other costs of that matter.

II. CONDITIONS FOR COLLECTOR SALE

- a) All Interested bidders must take note that some of the containers are not for sale, only the goods inside the containers are on sale. Therefore, bidders can only tender for the goods that are in these containers.
- b) Customs reserves the right to withdraw any goods from the sale at any time during the tender process.
- c) Customs reserves the right to accept or reject any tender submission.
- d) All bidders shall be deemed to have submitted their tender having consideration of a physical inspection. Bidders must ensure to inspect the goods at the time and date specified in PNG Customs advertisement. No alternative inspection times will be available.



- e) Appropriate, fully enclosed footwear must be worn during inspection. PNG Customs and its contractor reserve the right to refuse entry to the holding yard if footwear is not considered suitable.
- f) Customs will not take any responsibility for changes to the condition of any goods following inspection.
- g) Customs does not warrant the conditions of the goods in any way as all goods are sold on an “As is where is basis”.
- h) Information received from any other Customs officer may not be accurate and will not be binding upon PNG Customs.
- i) No representation made by or on behalf of PNG Customs shall be binding on PNG Customs unless that representation is in writing.
- j) Lobbying or canvassing with Customs officers or staff during this process may be cause for disqualification from consideration.
- k) Customs duty and tax shall be applicable on the goods. Bidders are hereby informed that different goods classifications attract different duty rates.

III. CONDITIONS FOR SUCCESSFUL BIDDERS

- a) Once a successful bidder is awarded the tender and payment settled, the successful bidder is required to remove the awarded goods from the holding yard within five (5) days from the time the successful bidder is notified.
- b) The successful bidder is required to show interest within two (2) days from the time successful bidder is notified, by advising Customs that payment arrangement will be made
- c) Storage fees will incur after the seven (7) days lapse.
